What is Google Classroom?

Think of Google Classroom (GC) as your child's digital link to learning.

Teachers use GC to share assignments, homework, newsletters, and much more with students AND parents!



Parent Access

As a Parent, you will access Google Classroom as YOUR CHILD with their username and password.

This tutorial is meant to show you what YOUR CHILD will do with Google Classroom.

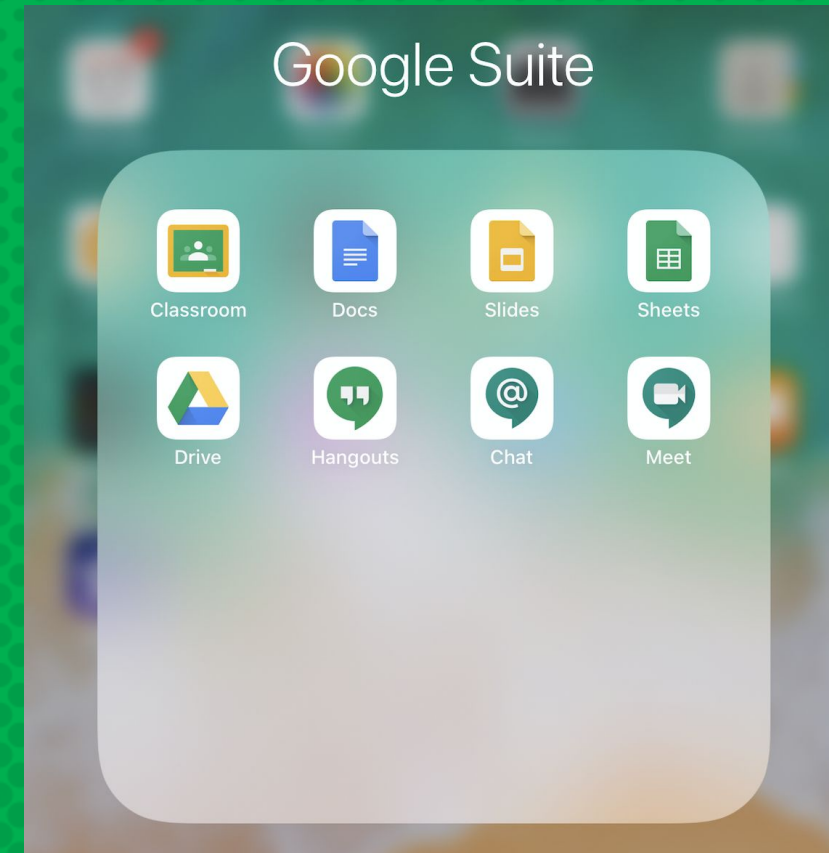


GOOGLE SUITE

There are separate apps on your iPad for each of the Google tools.

DO NOT GO THROUGH SAFARI OR CHROME on your iPad to access Google Apps on your iPad.

Google created these apps to have the best experience on your iPad.



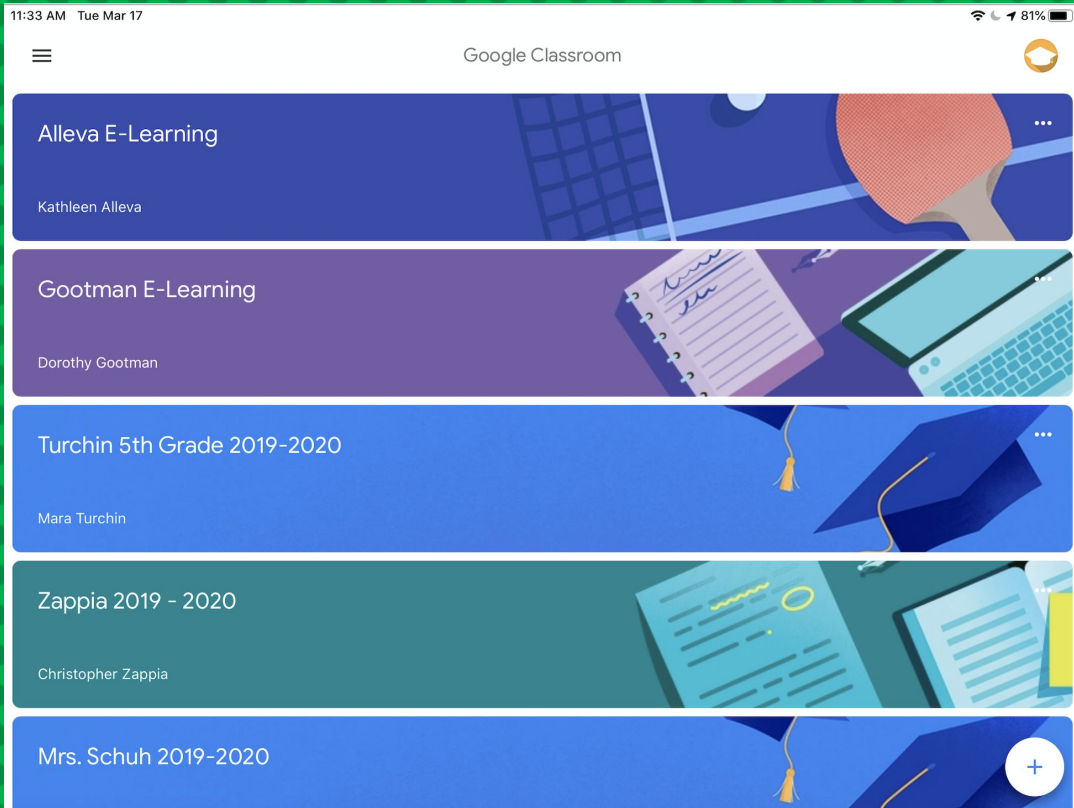


