
### What is a Chromebook?

A Chromebook is a device that connects to the Internet and is designed to be used with a Google account.

A user can access all of the G Suite apps that are available on the school Google domain.

### Why is it different?

- It does not have a large hard drive so it is not meant to have programs installed on it.
- It does not have a CD Drive.
- It is lightweight and able to process and access information quickly.





- > There is no:
  - DELETE key
  - CAPS lock key
  - HOME and END keys






# The Top Row Explained

- 1 Escape key
- Go BACK a page in browser
- Go to NEXT page in browser
- Refresh your browser
- **5** Full Screen

Switch desktop mode




- 7 Set screen dimmer low
- Set screen dimmer high
- Mute sound
- Set volume lower
- Set volume higher
- Power off the device


### **Common Keyboard Shortcuts**

Press and hold down the CTRL key and the letter

- ➤ COPY CTRL + C
- ➢ PASTE CTRL + V
- > CUT CTRL + X
- Undo CTRL + Z
- Keyboard help CTRL + ALT +?

## **Keyboard Shortcuts**

#### No DELETE Key - instead use:

- ALT + Backspace deletes a character ahead of the cursor
- CTRL + Backspace deletes a previous word

#### No CAPS LOCK key - instead use:

- ➤ ALT + Search key
- Toggle it again to disable it

# **Keyboard Shortcuts**

No HOME Key - instead use:

> ALT + Up Arrow

No END key - instead use:

ALT + Down arrow


## The Touchpad Shortcuts

- > There are no buttons on the touchpad! 😲
- Instead you will need to know touchpad shortcuts to navigate your session on the Chromebook.

To Single Click - TAP the touchpad ONCE with ONE finger.



To RIGHT Click - TAP the touchpad ONCE with TWO fingers





### **Scrolling!**

Place TWO fingers on the touchpad and move them up and down to scroll **vertically.** 

Place TWO fingers on the touchpad and move them left to right to scroll **horizontally.**
