3. Attach the picture to an assignment

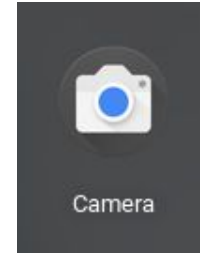
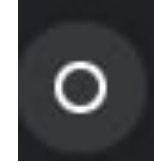

# Access your Camera and Take a Picture

- Click the launcher circle in the lower left corner or swipe up
- Find the camera app (scroll or search)
- Optional - Why not pin it to your shelf (press or click and hold on the icon and select "Pin to shelf")
- Tap the camera app to open it
- Tap the icon to switch to the camera on the keyboard
- Fold the Chromebook so the screen and keyboard are on the outside
- Position the Chromebook so the work is showing on the screen.
- Tap the button to take the picture.

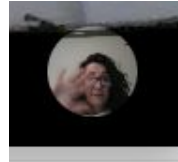

- Tap the icon to see the last picture you took.



- Tap the crop icon

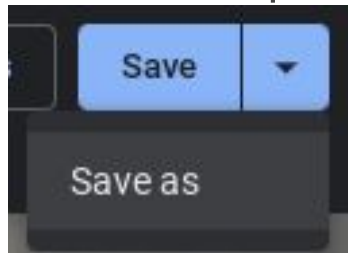


- Rotate and crop as needed

- Click Done or Close



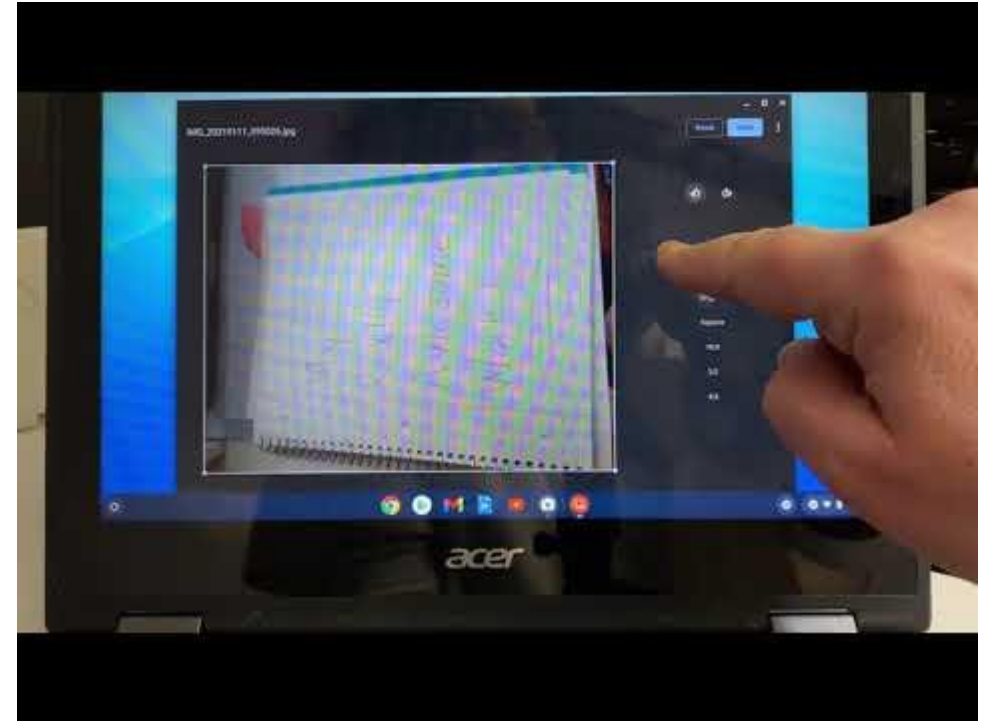
- Click the dropdown next to Save and tap Save As



- Tap Downloads

- Give the file a good name







- Tap Save

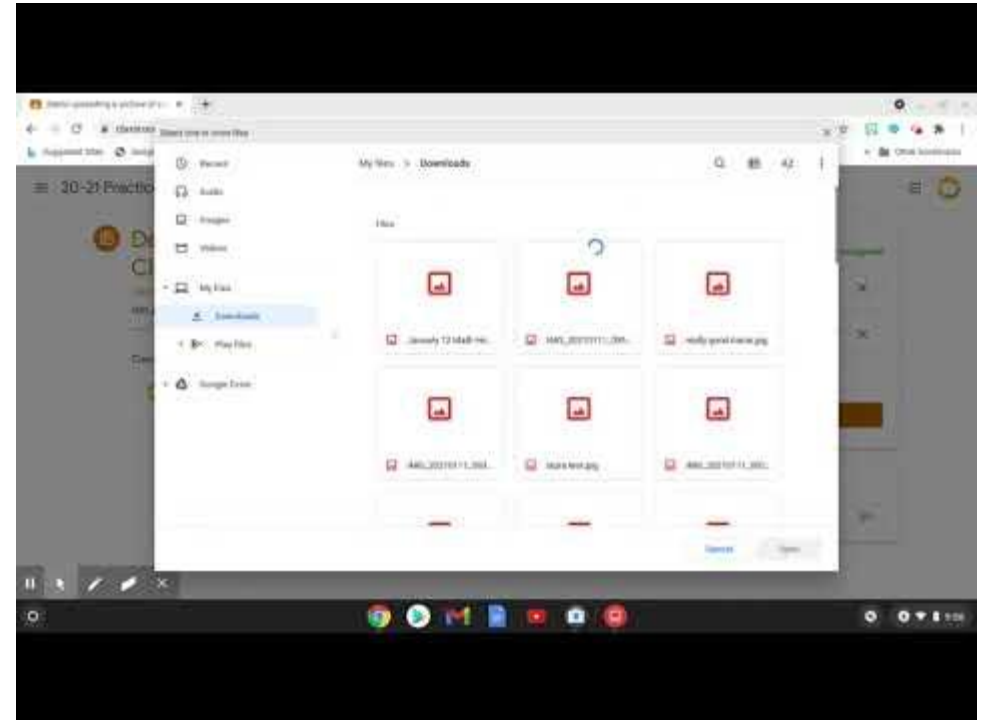
