Author: Dina Anastasio

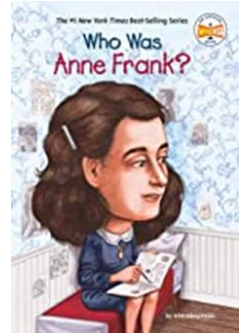
Review: “This book is interesting and teaches you about the Eiffel Tower. My favorite detail is about how it was built.” – Olivia Bragino

Review: “I love this text because it is informational and very interesting to read about Anne Frank and how she escaped from the war.” – Grace Mullin



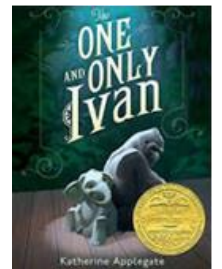
Title of Book: *The One and Only Ivan*

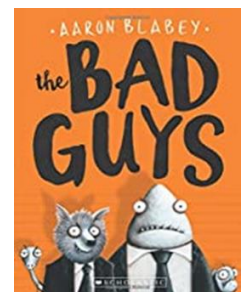


Title of Book: *Bad Guys*
